2019 Children's Theater Internship Application Red Bluff, CA

In our internship program, you and a couple other carefully selected high school students can assist the organization and execution of The Angelica Player's summer theater programming. You will have the opportunity to work with children from ages 6-14, helping cultivate a love of theater in the youth of our community. The internship starts the week before the intensive begins with collaborative sessions in which we help guide you to be fully prepared to work with children in this age group. This includes teaching you engaging theater games, teaching strategies, and a foundation of theater knowledge to help you in your role during the camp and in your future experiences with theater.

The material of this intensive aims to provide a representative experience of theater, including workshops on auditions, directing, and prop making, and many more. You will also have the opportunity to intentionally develop a lesson focused on an area of theater of your choice, and learn how to deliver the information to this group in a fun and meaningful way.

This internship is created for you, with the objective of giving you the opportunity to gain experience working with children, learn how to teach theater and facilitate, and further develop your special interest in the broader world of theater. This is your opportunity to shine as a role model and share your love for the arts.

This internship is open to high school students who have a strong interest in theater. The dates of the internship are July 15th through August 2nd, Monday through Friday. Times are specified below and reasonable exceptions are allowed. Applications are due by 6/1/19. - 3. What area of theater is of most interest to you? (i.e. If you had your dream job working in theater would it be a director? A costume designer? An actor?)
- 4. Have you worked with children before? If so, what age groups? Please elaborate.
- 5. There are two separate programs that work on similar subject matter throughout the week.
 - a. The Summer Theater Camp works with children ages 6 9 and has a focus on theater games and play as we guide the kids through workshops based on all different aspects of theater. This camp meets from 9am 12pm Monday through Friday.
 - b. The Summer Theater Intensive works with children ages 10-14 and has a curriculum that is a little more rigorous, giving them a lot more autonomy and responsibility as we move through the preparations to put on a performance. This intensive meets from 1-4pm Monday through Friday.

- 6. In addition to the time commitment listed above, we will meet from 9am 12pm or 1pm 4 pm, respectively, Monday through Friday the week before camp begins. This prepares you for camp and allows time to start developing your interest in theater. At the end of the camp, both groups meet at 4 on Friday to perform a cumulative show. This typically lasts until around 8, when the show is over. Do you have any conflicts with this schedule?
